***The Archdiocese of Detroit's Office for Safe Environment requires ALL volunteers to complete a three-hour Protecting God's Children Workshop and submit information for a background check. (Please submit a copy of your Protecting God's Children certificate to the Main Office if you have already taken the workshop.)**

Especially for Families Who Receive Financial Aid: you are expected to volunteer according to the following schedule: IF YOU RECEIVE

Up to \$1000 - parents are expected to volunteer for 10 hours

Up to \$2000 - parents are expected to volunteer for 15 hours

Up to \$3000 - parents are expected to volunteer for 20 hours

Above \$3000 - parents are expected to volunteer 25 hours

The above hours are the total for a family, but does not include the student volunteer expectation.

Your son(s) should plan to volunteer at a De La Salle related event. These events are the Open House, the CBA Christmas Craft Show, and Evening of Delights. Sign up announcements for these student opportunities will be made during the school day by the various event coordinators.

Please notice that most of the volunteer opportunities occur at the beginning of the school year with less opportunities during the latter part of the school year.

2017-2018 Volunteer Opportunities

1. Summer Camps June 19-August 4 (no volunteers July3-7)
